RE: Fall Migration Alert

Fall migration is currently underway, and the Wildlife Protection Society urges drivers to PLEASE SLOW DOWN!! The migration season runs through December and can often extend into January. Animals usually travel in groups and follow the same routes. If you frequently see dead animals in the same spot, slow down and be alert as this may indicate the presence of an established migration route.

The most dangerous time for collisions is between dusk and dawn. Deer, elk and moose may be crossing the road in route to their winter habitat. Damage from collisions with these large animals can cost thousands of dollars in vehicle repair, injuries, and sometimes death—for both animal and human. Our region has the highest rate of vehicle/animal collisions in the State of Utah. During these peak periods, please be alert and drive with caution on the following roads: I 80, US 40, SR 224, SR 248, SR 32, SR 189, and county roads in Browns Canyon, and River Road to Midway.
