The Summit County Council, in its role as the governing body of the Snyderville Basin Special Recreation District, is seeking public input regarding the proposed Resolution 2010-11, a bond for up to \$25 million that is slated to be on the November ballot. If approved, the bonds would be used to finance all or a portion of the costs of acquiring recreational open space property, constructing trails and related improvements, and paying costs of issuance of the bonds. The public is encouraged to attend the County Council meeting on **Wednesday, September 1, at 6:00 p.m., at the Sheldon Richins Building** at 1885 West Ute Blvd at Kimball Junction, to provide comment on the potential issuance of the bonds, and any potential economic impact that the improvements, facilities, or properties financed in whole or in part with the proceeds of the bonds may have on the private sector.
